



Ten Mile River Pre-Camp 2025

You may choose any number of the sessions:		
Pre-Camp Week 1	May 18th to May 24th	Prepare Family Camp for Memorial Day Weekend. Serve as Family Camp program and support staff for that weekend.
Pre-Camp Week 2	May 25th to May 31st	
Pre-Camp Week 3	June 1st to June 7th	Prepare Keowa for the OA Conclave. Serve as support staff for that weekend.
Pre-Camp Week 4	June 8th to June 14th	Finish preparation for all camps for the summer camping season.
Pre-Camp Week 5	June 15th to June 21st	

Duties: All Pre-Camp staff will be under the direction of the Crew Leader, but also report directly to Jim Loeffel, head ranger. These staff understand they are supporting all of Ten Mile River Scout Reservation and its needs, regardless of home camp.

Hours: Staff is responsible to begin the day at 8am. The crew leader will assign the day's tasks. There will be a 30 minute break for lunch. The day ends around 4:30pm. Staff will have one day off a week to be determined by Jim Loeffel or his designee.

Uniform: None required. Come prepared to work hard and get dirty. Boots and work gloves are required. It can still get quite chilly in early June; expect nights in the 40's or even 30's. Pack appropriately.

Housing: Pre-camp staff will be housed in the Keowa Log Cabin. Sleeping quarters will be a shared space on mesh cots with mattresses. The cabin is heated, has wifi, a bathroom/shower, and full kitchen.

Food:

There is no food service available during this time, except a few council-related events (Conclave, Raft-o-Ree, etc). Pre-camp staff are responsible for providing their meals. The crew leader will help arrange food, shopping, or occasionally eating out.
