Transporting Scouts Safely Unit Leaders Check-In 2.8.24

- To ensure safe travels, let's adopt some best practices outlined in the BSA's "Transporting Scouts Safely" guidance:
 - Silence Your Device
 - Choose Rest Stops
 - Pull Over Safely
 - No Texting While Driving
 - Ensure that Scouts are safe in their seats before departing
 - Do no offer rides to Scouts while in camp

Registration Process

- \$65 per camper deposit due February 1st
 - Scout's names are required per deposit.
 - Scout registrations are not transferable.
- Full payment due by March 15th to secure Early-Bird Discount
 - \$65 camper deposit must have been submitted by the February 1st deadline.
 - Merit badge registration will go live on April 1st –
 Full payment is required to register for merit badges
- TMR Legacy Gift Cards
 - Please contact council offices to redeem for registration

Campership Process

- GNYC & Out-Of-Council Camperships applications are now available at tenmileriver.org/camperships/
- All applications are reviewed by a campership committee
- Process will start on February 29th
- \$65 deposit is required for consideration

- Used to pay camp fees & register for Merit Badges

- Staff are also available to coach your unit on how to implement Parent Portal.
